Course Description:

Post Media I introduces students to the world of post-production for photography and film. Students will learn how to use Adobe Creative Cloud programs to edit and design their work. They will not only learn the techniques to use these programs, but they will also train their eye to understand what makes a visually appealing image and film.

Objectives:

- Students will learn the principals of design and how to implement it in their work.
- Students will learn the interface, the tools, the features, tricks, and tips for using Photoshop CC.
- Students will gain an understanding of how digital images work.
- Students will get a thorough overview of the interface, tools, features, and production flow for Premiere Pro CC.
- Students will learn how to tell stories though graphic design.
- Students will learn how editing impacts a film through analysis of films and through practice.

Screenings:

A portion of this class involves watching and critically analyzing films. In-class films may be rated PG, PG-13, or R-rated TV-MA (for mature language). Signing the syllabus is considered as permission for your child to screen these films in class.

Attendance:

Attending school is required by DC Law. Therefore, our goal is that our students attend school **every day and on time**.

- Students with 1 or 2 unexcused absences will have their parent/guardian notified of absence.
- Students with 5 or more unexcused absences during a single advisory will receive a grade reduction. Parent/Guardian and student will also be required to have a Student Support Team meeting conducted by Attendance Counselor.

- Students with 10 total absences-excused or unexcused- will be referred to the school’s Attendance Office for follow up.
- Students with 15 unexcused absences will be referred to Court Social Services.
- Students with 30 or more unexcused absences within a full school year will receive a final failing grade with a loss of course credit.

Class Conduct:

- Students are expected to be in class on time. Unexcused tardiness will result in 2 point deductions of final grade.
- Students are to keep their phones off at all times unless otherwise permitted. Continual phone disruptions will result in the phone being confiscated until the end of class.
- Students are not permitted to bring any food or drink into the class.
- Students may not remove any school property from the classroom unless permitted.
- Students are to be respectful of others when their classmates are talking.
- Students are not allowed to download any files, games, or programs on to computers unless permitted.
