Course Description:

Female Ensembles I & II are vocal ensemble courses offered for qualified female vocal majors. The Ensembles performs music literature of Baroque through contemporary periods as selected by the instructor.

Content Standards:

- Students sing alone and with others, a varied repertoire of music representing diverse genres, styles and cultures.
- Students read, notate, and interpret notational symbols for rhythmic and melodic patterns.
- Students explore a variety of heritages from music of many cultures.

Required Materials:

Each student must have the following:

- Pencil
- Water bottle
- Character shoes (for performance)

Assessment:

Students will be graded on attendance and the quality of performance participation.

Factors in performance assessments: vocal production; ability to read score; music interpretation.
