The Summer Intensive:

This 3-week intensive is designed as an introductory course to the Technical Design and Production program. Students will receive the fundamentals and basic foundation needed to grow in the area of design and production.

Courses/Curriculum:

Basic Stage Craft/Production 101. This course is divided into content areas and introduces students to the technical aspects of theatrical production, which include **lighting, sound design, sewing** and **make-up**. Classroom work will be heavily supplemented with interactive hands-on training.

Math for the Technician. This course is designed to help navigate the emerging theatrical designer and technician through often complex concepts required throughout the production process. A technician often has to calculate, measure, sketch, fabricate and manipulate objects to achieve a design idea. Students will learn Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematic principles that directly apply to Stage Craft, Lighting, Costumes and the like.
